"We want everyone to know that we are so much more than just a football and cheer club."

The High Point Tigers play in the Central Carolina Youth Football League (CCYFL), an affiliate of the United Youth Football and Cheer League (UYFL). The league is comprised of 15 teams in Central North Carolina region and field teams in the 6u, 8u, 10u and 12u age classifications. The Tigers will host its home opener on September 17th, 2016 at Washington Terrace Park in High Point.
